

Ryerson University Project Funding Allocations Committee for Students (P-FACS) Committee Member Position Description

P-FACS is the Project Funding Allocations Committee for Students. This is a committee of students that determines how to distribute money from the Student Projects Fund to ensure that students with creative ideas are able to bring those ideas to life for the betterment of Ryerson's campus. Proposals are assessed by the committee to evaluate how they will make Ryerson's campus life more vibrant, promote the image of Ryerson University and enhance the quality of student lives outside of the classroom.

Committee members representing each faculty at Ryerson are selected through an application process to sit on P-FACS. In addition, Committee members are appointed to represent RSU, OVPS, and CESAR. This committee is in place to ensure that decisions are made in the interests of all students at Ryerson University.

Responsibilities:

- Attending P-FACS training sessions (mandatory).
- Preparing for, attending and actively participating in 12-14 evening meetings over the course of the coming academic year (approximately 2.5 hours each).
- Actively listening to presentations by other students and ask questions to gain an understanding of how funds will be used and benefit the Ryerson community.
- Actively contributing to the discussion of, and final decision to allocate funding.
- Being a good steward of the finances allocated to P-FACS.
- Participating in the Board succession and application process

Qualifications

- Experience being involved at school – high school, college and/or university
- Demonstrated experience working with others and encouragement of others to be active and engaged
- Ability to understand, assess and reason how a project, activity or initiative will operate and benefit a community
- Previous leadership experience an asset

Each Committee Member is expected to fulfill their obligations for the entire P-FACS cycle (September – April).
